## 1 year to 2 years



**Potty Training** – Begin to show interest in the potty, sit with support, and understand the need to go.



**Identifying Numbers 1-20** – Recognize numbers 1-10, count with help, and identify quantities.



**Identify and Say Common Body Parts** – Identify and name basic body parts including eyes, nose, ears, mouth, hands, and feet.



**Match Simple Objects** – Match identical objects and identify everyday items.



**Sort & Identify Simple Shapes** – Sort shapes by type (circle, square, triangle) and name them.



**Recognize Familiar People (Mom, Dad, Grammy)** – Identify and name immediate family members and close caregivers.



**Identify and Say Basic Colors** – Identify and name primary colors: red, blue, yellow, green.



**Identify and Say Common Animals** – Identify animals by name and sound.



**Complete Simple Shape Sorters** – Place shapes in the correct openings and complete simple puzzles.



**Understand Cause and Effect** – Explore how actions make things happen.



**Engage in Pretend Play** – Pretend to feed, cook, talk on the phone, and care for dolls or toys.



**Routines** – Understand daily routines and anticipate what comes next.



**Smooth Transitions from One Scenario to Another** – Transition with minimal reminders and follow along with the group.
